1. Allocation of seat shall be subject to the information furnished by the candidate (concerning his/her qualification & category and fulfillment of the same as per eligibility criteria as laid down in admission brochure 2025-26) and shall be provisional till the final physical verification of documents is completed during counseling. **In case of any discrepancy, her / his candidature will automatically stand canceled.**
2. Candidates are required to produce the proof of the minimum qualification at the time of the interview. In case, the final result is not declared kindly prudence all the previous year's details.
3. Candidate is required to report (in person) to participate in the **Counseling cum Admission Process** along with relevant documents (whichever is/are applicable) to the University. **The list of required Documents are as under:**

16. Any other relevant documents (Gap Year Affidavit or other if required)

*Ph.D. applicants must be required to produce relevant Research Proposal in approx. 1500 word at the time of Interview.

The Ph.D. scholar is required to complete his/her course work in classroom mode during the first year while working professional applicant is required to produce a letter of consent from his/her organization that it will provide sufficient facilities and enough time to scholar for completing the course work and further conducting the research. **(To be produced at the time of interview)**
5. For the working professional category in the Ph.D. program, a candidate is required to have two years of teaching and /or research experience in National Institutes of higher learning/University/Central Laboratories or two years experience in Industry/R&D of the industry at an appropriate level.

Further;

1. UGC Guideline issued for Ph.D. Admissions from **June 2024** Session onwards will be applicable for - **category-1** (Award of JRF and appointment as Assistant Professor), **category-2** (Appointment as Assistant Professor and admission to Ph.D.), and **category-3** (Admission to Ph.D. only) candidates with their respective validity as per UGC' Ph.D. Admission Guidelines.
 - For admission in Ph.D., the marks obtained in the NET by the candidates under category-2 and category-3 will be valid for a period of one year from the date of declaration of the result of UGC-NET. The validity of such candidate's certificate should be valid till the date of Interview, i.e. 20-01-2026.
2. All candidates having "NET/JRF for Assistant Professor" certificate, **prior to June 2024** will be considered as qualified for interview.
