Reasoning and Aptitude: Vocabulary Based (Synonyms Antonyms), English Usage or Grammar, Sentence Correction, Fill in the blanks, Jumbled Paragraph, Meaning-Usage Match, Summary Questions, Verbal Reasoning, Facts / Inferences / Judgments, Reading Comprehension

Mathematical Ability & Data Interpretation: Number Systems, LCM and HCF, Percentage, Profit and Loss, Interest (Simple and Compound), Speed, Time and Distance, Time and Work, Average, Ratio and Proportion, Linear Equations, Quadratic Equations, Progressions, Probability, Geometry, Tables, Column graphs, Bar Graphs, Line charts, Pie Chart, Venn Diagrams.

English Proficiency: Idioms and phrases, antonyms, related words, etc. Grammar-based questions test the candidate's ability to spot and correct grammatical errors. CAT generally tests knowledge of high school level grammar and includes areas like subject-verb agreement, use of articles, prepositions, etc.
